REPORT ON THE HISTORY OF LEKKERWATER SECONDARY SCHOOL

Lekkerwater secondary School started operating in 2016. It was founded by the Presbyterian Church. The school is located some 30 km east of Marondera town in Mashonalnd East.

Lekkerwater Secondary School opened its doors with a teacher establishment of 3, two males and 1 female. It had an enrolment of 21 learners. Teacher establishment increased to 4 in 2017. By June 2018 the teacher establishment was 5, with two female teachers and four male teachers. Leaner enrolment had increased to 113. The number of teachers increased to six in 2020 to date.
