The reserve is about a mile north of Foxearth village, between the River Stour
and the lane north-west of Constable's Farm and Constable's Barn
(private dwellings with postcode CO10 7HZ).

From Long Melford travelling west towards Clare (A1092), turn first left after GCB Cocoa
(formerly Philips Avent), signposted 'Pentlow Road'. Then take the next left (signposted 'Liston')
and the reserve is about 200 metres on the left.
