Nicaragua. All are available to download here:



You will find an accompanying video on our YouTube channel: bit.ly/Greta\_Connect\_Youtube There is also an intergenerational celebration resource for use with all ages.




#### THE CLUBHOUSE HOLIDAY CLUB 2025—NEW FREE RESOURCE

She

also turned her jokes into a booklet which she sold to raise money for Comic Relief. Zoe clearly takes her joking very seriously—described as "a small but significant service, and by far not the only thing she does for the church".
